## 40-Minute War – Miller's Vets – Real-Life Acting Hero!

### The 40-Minute War

Actually, according to what we've read, it was only 38 minutes — 9:02 – 9:40 AM, then it was all over! The year was 1896. There are two sides to the story and no-one around to verify either:

1. Admiral Sir Henry Rawson ordered the British fleet under his command into waters off Zanzibar's harbor, so his officers and sailors could disembark to watch a cricket match in which the British were to participate. The concentration of warships angered the sultan, so he immediately declared war, sending his lone battleship, *Glasgow*, into action. The British fleet bombarded the sultan's palace, reduced it to rubble, and killed or injured 500 of the sultan's soldiers. When the *Glasgow* opened fire, the British big guns zeroed in on the vessel and sank it.

2. When the pro-British sultan of Zanzibar died, he was succeeded by one who was less partial to British interests. The new sultan ignored an 1886 treaty requiring him to be approved by the British consul, so Britain viewed his act as cause for war. They ordered the sultan to vacate the palace. Instead, he barricaded himself inside. When the time limit on the ultimatum expired, British forces sent to the island invaded. The sultan took asylum in the

German consulate before fleeing, and Britain soon put a sultan on the throne more to their liking.

Wherever the truth may lie, one thing is agreed upon: it was the shortest war in history!

This is a drill team of selected homeless veterans in South Bend, Indiana, formed in January 2009 by Robert L. Miller, Sr., a former St. Joseph Superior Court Judge and Lieutenant Commander, U. S. They have uniforms and have refreshed prior military experiences pertaining to marching, parading and posting of the Colors. As they once served their nation, they now serve their community.
